CIT Information

Our Counselor-in-Training Program offers qualified young volunteers an opportunity to support Historic Spanish Point in efforts to provide a value-added Summer Camp Program to children between the ages of 7-10 years old. In this role, our youth volunteers' emphasis is on developing leadership skills, sensitivity to children, and program skills.

The Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Program is an intensive, hands-on training experience that gives teen campers valuable insight into the role of a camp counselor.

Guided by an experienced Senior and Junior Camp Counselors, CITs will develop their decision-making and problem-solving skills by assisting with daily activities and camper care.

CIT Requirements

Participation in the CIT program is by selection. Interested applicants will need to complete an application form and attend an interview. The first step is to have a parent/guardian complete the online camper application.

Applicants must be at least 15 years old at the start of their CIT session.

Applicants must possess a genuine interest in recreational youth development and in working with campers ages 7-10.

CITs must be willing to commit the required energy, enthusiasm, and positive attitude to all aspects of the training program.
